






Care and Maintenance

How to Empty Water

After playing for a while, water will accumulate in U-bend #1

- **1.** Remove mouthpiece from BFB Natural Trumpet[™]
- **2.** Rotate trumpet front to back to empty water (as shown)



How to Clean the BFB Natural Trumpet™

Soak the BFB Natural Trumpet[™] in warm, soapy water with an antibacterial liquid dish detergent. Use a trumpet snake* to clean the leadpipe and first U-bend thoroughly. Rinse the instrument by running warm water through it (ensure it is empty as shown above) and pat it dry with a towel. Clean the mouthpiece using the same method, but with a mouthpiece brush*. When not in use, store the BFB Natural Trumpet[™] in its carrying case.
